Lamborghini smartphone interface

Applies to vehicles with: Lamborghini smartphone interface

Set-up

Lamborghini smartphone interface allows you to connect your smartphone to the multimedia system. Certain content from your smartphone is displayed on the multimedia system, where compatible with driving, and can be managed via the multimedia system.

WARNING

- **Configuration and settings must be made by the driver only with the vehicle completely stationary, and when road and traffic conditions allow.**
- **The driver's first responsibility is to pay attention to the road. When you are behind the wheel, you are responsible for traffic safety: an accident may occur!**
- **Excessively high volumes can cause permanent hearing damage and impair the driver's perception abilities! An injury could occur! Keep the volume at a reasonable level. Avoid having the volume at a level which prevents hearing conversations or other audible signals coming from outside the vehicle, for example the sirens of emergency vehicles: otherwise an accident could occur!**

Requirement

The vehicle is parked and the instrument cluster is on, and you have an iPhone® 5 or later running iOS 7.1.2 or later, or else a smartphone with Android™ Auto and Android™ 6 or greater (for devices running Android™ 6.0 Lollipop to Android™ 10, it will also be necessary to install the Android™ Auto app in advance from

the Google Play Store). You will also need the devices' original USB cables.

Connection via USB socket

- Connect the smartphone via a USB adapter (see p. 369).
- Follow the system instructions.
- Note and follow any further system requests displayed on the smartphone.

Wireless connection

Available for mobile devices which support the Apple CarPlay™ and Android™ Auto wireless option.

- With the vehicle stationary, enable the connection and Bluetooth® visibility on the mobile device.
- Connect the device to the multimedia system (see p. 369).
- Once the Bluetooth connection procedure is complete, confirm use of Apple CarPlay™/Android™ Auto in wireless mode on the multimedia system (option available where supported by the mobile device).
- Note and follow any further system requests displayed on the smartphone.

If you did not allow Apple CarPlay™ or Android™ Auto to run when the smartphone was first connected, it is possible to start up the Lamborghini smartphone interface at a later date.

- Open the **CONNECT** menu > **Devices** > **Smartphone Interface**; alternatively **CONNECT** > **Apple CarPlay™/Android™ Auto**.
- You can select your smartphone from the list of previously paired devices (4 – Fig. 197 - see p. 369).
- Follow the system instructions.

If you did not allow Apple CarPlay™ or Android™ Auto to run when the smartphone was first connected, it is possible to start up the Lamborghini smartphone interface at a later date from the

main screen of the multimedia system by pressing and holding the **CONNECT** button.

- Once the Bluetooth® connection procedure is complete, confirm use of Apple CarPlay™\ Android™ Auto in wireless mode on the multimedia system (option available where supported by the mobile device).
- Note and follow any further system requests displayed on the smartphone.

If you did not allow Apple CarPlay™ or Android™ Auto to run when the smartphone was first connected, it is possible to start up the Lamborghini smartphone interface at a later date via **CONNECTED DEVICES**.

- Select the initial screen, open the **SETTINGS** menu > **CONNECTED DEVICES** > **LAMBORGHINI SMARTPHONE INTERFACE**.
